This is to update that the [Mountain Laurel Pony Club](#) (MLPC) hosting a fund raising equestrian event to be held in the Horse Arena barn at the [Bloomsburg Fairground](#) **March 29 & 30**, 2008, and going forward as an **annual** event.

This is a two-day dressage clinic featuring **Lendon Gray**, two time equestrian Olympian and host of the annual [Youth Dressage Festival](#) in Saugerties NY.

Mountain Laurel Pony Club is one of 13 pony clubs in the **Eastern PA Region** and will organize all the details in the weeks to come. Our riders compete in Dressage, Show Jumping, and Eventing. They ride at PLUM RIDGE ACADEMY, INC. in Nescopeck, PA. Coached and instructed by Laverne Pendziwiatr and Jennifer Greshko. We have riders competing at the USPC Nationals each year.

The event is open to any rider of any age or skill level interested in learning from one to the top trainer/coaches in the nation. Membership in our organization or USPC is not necessary. Negative Coggins thru 3/30/08 required. Forms posted soon.

The cost is \$85 per rider including a 1 hr (+/-) group (4 or 5 riders) lesson followed by a dressage test scored by an “L” rated judge. \$35 to audit. Participants will be grouped by skill level or can be scheduled as a team to facilitate your traveling convenience. If you wish to ride both days the fee is \$170 for a total of two lessons. Stabling is available for \$25 for the weekend. (Bring your own bedding, STRAW ONLY, and strip stalls). Dress is casual. Register between 1/1/08 and 2/28/08.

The lunch break will include demonstrations of Musical Freestyle and (hopefully) a Quadrille Dressage. Suggestions are welcome.

Most of the weekend will consist of group clinics, totaling more that 16 hours with Lendon. There has never been such an opportunity for riders in eastern and central Pennsylvania outside of the Devon area, and we are looking forward to being able to use an indoor facility appropriate to the quality and convenience of our audience.
